

Welcome to BRADWORTHY TRANSPORT MUSEUM

Bradworthy Transport Museum opened in 2006 and is the realisation of a lifelong ambition of Ken Wilson who started his collection with a 1938 Rover 10.

The museum now houses over 100 historic vehicles comprised of lorries, vans, cars, motorcycles, tractors and farm equipment dating back to 1914. There are also thousands of other memorabilia - almost anything you can think of from stationary engines to oil cans, advertising signs to tractor seats and much more just keep your eyes open as you move around!



Ken's collection includes numerous rare vehicles including a right hand drive Canadian Chrysler, a 1932 Hillman Minx, a 1948 3-wheeled Reliant van and a 1948 Fordson 7V Tipper lorry. Among the bikes is a 1914 Douglas motorbike and foreign vehicles a cute little 1926 Hanomag and 3 very rare French tractors.

Many of the museums treasures arrive in a very sorry state and are lovingly and painstakingly restored using, where ever possible, carefully sourced original parts.

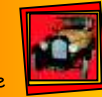
